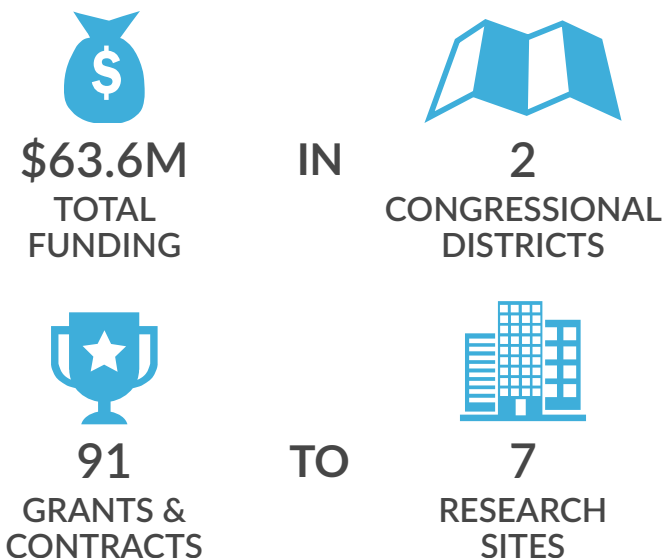

BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH IN HAWAII



- \$975K** NIH funding for workforce training and development grants in Hawaii, which help prepare the scientific leaders of the future
- \$12.5M** NIH funding to two Hawaii businesses for research and development of technology offering potential commercial applications
- 2.99K** Bioscience industry jobs in Hawaii, which offer an average annual wage \$23.6K higher than the total private sector (2020 TEconomy/BIO Report)
- 306** Bioscience industry business establishments in Hawaii operating in 2018 (2020 TEconomy/BIO Report)
