- \$1.85M** NIH funding for workforce training and development grants in New Mexico, which help prepare the scientific leaders of the future
- \$3.92M** NIH funding to seven New Mexico businesses for research and development of technology offering potential commercial applications
- 7.22K** Bioscience industry jobs in New Mexico, which offer an average annual wage \$31.3K higher than the total private sector (2018 TEconomy/BIO Report)
