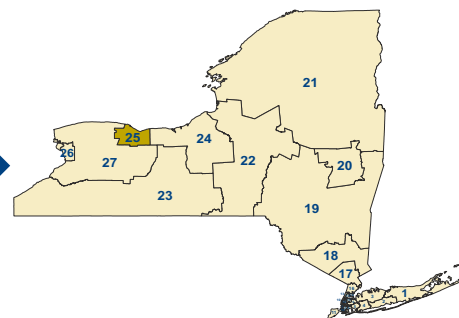


# 2020 FEDERAL RESEARCH FUNDING
