8 IDeA GRANTS to build research capacity

- \$17.2M** awarded to THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH DAKOTA
- \$6.88M** awarded to NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY
- \$673K** awarded to SANFORD RESEARCH NORTH (formerly the Neuropsychiatric Research Institute)



BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH IN NORTH DAKOTA



- \$445K** NIH funding for workforce training and development grants in North Dakota, which help prepare the scientific leaders of the future
- 3.96K** Bioscience industry jobs in North Dakota, which offer an average annual wage \$20.8K higher than the total private sector (2020 TEconomy/BIO Report)
- 570** Bioscience industry business establishments in North Dakota operating in 2018 (2020 TEconomy/BIO Report)
