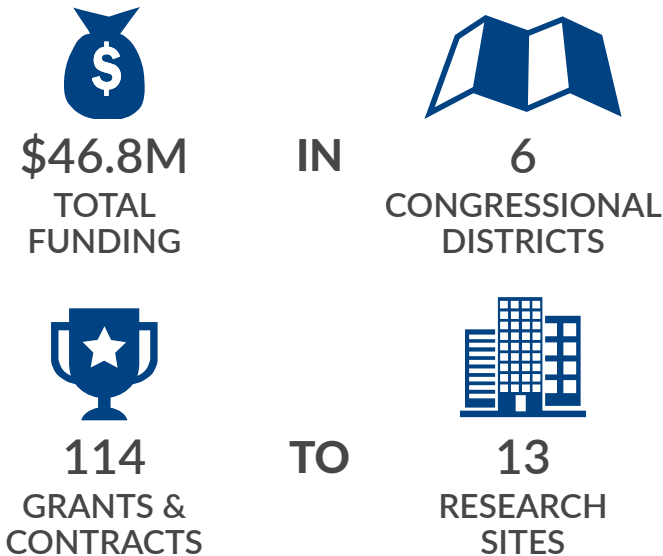


2020 Federal Research Funding
