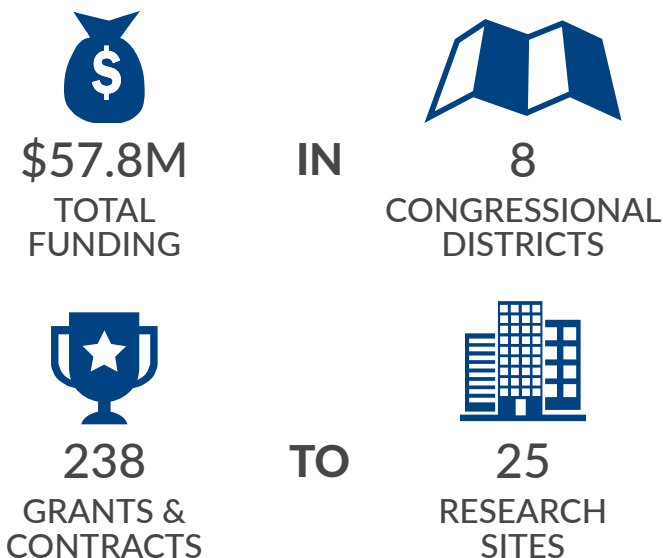




2019 Federal Research Funding
